## Dates for the season

Welcome back to indoor bowling. We hope you all had an enjoyable summer.

The club is open **7AM Monday 29th September**.

At Christmas we close Tuesday 23rd December at 10.30pm and re-open Friday 2nd January 2026, running until Friday 17th April 2026 culminating in the final evening of the season. The Summer Webber will commence from Monday 27th April 2026.

We are planning to do a one-day event over Christmas and also going to open for an additional day for social rollups, play a national or club competition on Monday 29th December (one day competition) and Tuesday 30th December (roll up/competitions). Timings to be confirmed closer to the time.

We have now launched our new online booking system. To book rinks go to the WIBC website - www.whiteknightsibc.co.uk - and click on the BOWLR link. This is a private site where only WIBC members can log in. You should have received an email explaining how to log in. Anyone who has not received their details please email Andy or call the club to get your details.

We are not using the BOWLR system to full capacity in year one, we want to try and make this a gradual process for our members and not overwhelm them with functions in the first year.

If you need help we are holding sessions in the club, just bring along your device. All fixtures are now published on the website; Andy has sent out all the fixtures in Excel set up as team sheets for each team. If any Captains need any assistance, please contact Andy or Morgan. These are laid out slightly differently this season due to our move to the BOWLR system.

# **Competitions Survey Feedback**

Thanks to everyone who completed the competitions feedback survey. The bowling group has analyzed the data and will be making the following adjustments for next season. We've discussed other competition formats, but want to see how the changes for next season work out before adding more to our busy schedule.

- **Super Sunday Pairs** will become a Mixed Pairs competition, played in line with EIBA rules. The winners will then go forward and represent WIBC in the London and Southern Counties Mixed Pairs competition for the 2026-27 season.
- Over 70's pairs for Men and Ladies will become Over 60's Pairs to bring in line with the EIBA age restricted competitions, we feel this will also have a positive effect on the entries to the competitions.
- Introducing a **New Bowlers Singles competition**, that will run in parallel to the New Bowlers league. This is likely to be a one-day competition run towards the end of the season.
- Ladies and Men's Two Wood Singles will be aimed at being played over 1 or 2 days to increase rink capacity and make events of the 2 competitions.
- Ladies drawn triples to be run as a one-day style event to try and help increase entries.
- A one day Australian pairs competition to be run by the bowling group.
- **Unbadged Singles**. While we found some anomalies in the competition entries, the overall number of participants is strong, so we're keeping the current format. We'll focus on promoting the events to increase ladies' entries.
- **Mixed ability competitions**. This year, we've introduced several popular mixed-ability competitions, such as the 'drawn triples' and 'fun triples', in response to survey feedback.
- Afternoon League Cups competitions. This year, we're offering finalists the option to play their matches in the afternoon instead of the evening. If this is a popular choice, we may make the change permanent for future competitions.
- Start dates for competitions. We'll aim to start competitions earlier in the season to avoid the usual end-of-season fixture congestion. We'll make every effort to schedule them to avoid clashes with national competitions.
